



# Teams Migration Benefits

## Better Performance and Project Management




### Fast & Scalable

- High data transfer speeds (500 Teams and .5-1TB per day\*)
- High concurrent migration of Teams similar to our standard mail migration process



### Simpler Project Management

- Easily autodiscover and select individual Teams and item types directly from the UI.
- Pre-Stage Destination Teams by migrating Teams and Channels, then data.
- See status, progress, and errors for each Team in your project.



### Enterprise Security


- Enhanced security for large-scale projects.
- Migrate with Application Permission (non-privileged user)

# What Can I Migrate in Teams?

## Tenant-to-Tenant Migration Scenario

### Supported Teams Components:

- **Teams** (Public and Private)
- **Conversation History** (structure, format, root messages, replies, fonts, bullets, lists, emojis, GIFs, and more, as well as timestamps in UTC)
- **Private Chats** (stored in Exchange Online and migrated as part of a standard mailbox migration)
- **Channels** (Public and Private)
- **Files & OneNote**
- **User Permissions**
- **Templates** (EDU)



# Microsoft Team Private Chats

## Microsoft Teams Private Chats

### MigrationWiz handles


- Chat titles  
*(When there's no title, the participants' names will be shown by default)*
- Chat participants
- GIFs in chats
- Embedded images
- **OneDrive Links**  
*(Will be mapped correctly only if OneDrive migration as has been completed – this is a pre-requisite)*
- Chats marked 'Important'  
*(E-mail item will appear flagged as 'Important')*
- Edited messages in a Chat
- Praise *(Icon/image not migrated)*
- Stickers
- Other content formatting and styling

### Does not migrate

- × Reactions
- × Forms
- × Polly
- × Saved messages
- × Deactivated user's chat
- × Chats on external tenant  
*(You are the guest of that tenant)*

### Limitations

1. Deleted messages in a chat are migrated
2. Private chats with file attachments will be migrated as an e-mail containing both the attached file and link to the file
3. Chat history prior to the user's addition into the group chat will not be migrated even if the 'Include all chat history' option was selected



# Autodiscover

## Adding Teams in MigrationWiz

### 1. Autodiscover Teams from the Source

### 2. Import Teams as individual line items

- Easily selectable within the UI
- Monitor status at the individual Team-level

### 3. Rename Teams within MigrationWiz

**Autodiscover Items**

**Start Autodiscover**

Starting Autodiscover will discover all teams at the source tenant.

Once the Autodiscover process has completed, either:


- Directly import all items as line items; OR
- Download the .csv file to manage the teams. The same file may then be uploaded via Bulk Add.



# Pre-Stage Teams Migrations

Structure first. Data second. Recommended order of operations for Teams projects.





# Conversation History

## Microsoft Teams



Example: end-user view of a migrated conversation thread from a different Teams tenant.

### Supported Components

- Public and private channel conversation history
- Structure, format, root messages, replies, fonts, bullets, lists, emojis, GIFs, and more
- Timestamps in UTC

Unlike other Teams solutions, MigrationWiz rehydrates the most recent conversations directly into channels on the destination.

- End users can reply to conversation threads from the previous tenant.
- Migrated threads are earmarked as being from the previous tenant.
- Older messages are stored in HTML tab at the top of channel.
  - The number of conversations rehydrated directly to channels is adjustable via advanced options but will impact overall data transfer speeds.

# Private Chat Migration

## Microsoft Teams

Private Chats are stored in Exchange and migrated as part of a standard mailbox project.

- Private Chats require a MigrationWiz Mailbox or User Migration Bundle license.
- Private Chats can be pre-staged and/or filtered by date range.
- OneDrive links in chats migrate.
- Once migrated, chat items can be found in the user's Outlook under a folder titled "Migrated Teams Chat."
- Statistics on chat migration can be found on the MigrationWiz report







# OneNote Migration


## Microsoft Teams

### Types of notebooks:

1. Default notebooks of the Team (migrated via Teams migration)
2. Notebooks created another Team and then added as link to public or private channel (migrated via Teams migration)
3. Personal notebooks stored in OneDrive and to Teams (migrated as part of a document migration with the User Migration Bundle)


### In many scenarios, MigrationWiz will migrate the notebooks and recreate the tabs automatically.

- Some exceptions apply to private channels or notebooks from another team's SharePoint site. [Consult our guide for specific information on your scenario.](#)
- Customers are encouraged to perform a successful document and OneNote pass first before recreating OneNote tabs.
- Migrated OneNote tabs will be reflected in the Folder Summary section under the respective team/channel.
- "Migrated Items" will also show the total number of OneNote notebooks and tabs migrated per channel.






